


Public Spending Rationalization Program – Growing expenditure value and e-proc platform usage

EXPENDITURE VALUE 2013-2020 (MLN/€)

- 700k procedures
- 90k Public Buyers

- An overall growth in the use of digital purchasing tools
- A change in the mix of tools: MEPA, DPS and ASP tenders are growing... greater awareness of the PAs on the use of e-proc tools

The e-Proc platform role in Consip's engagement in Covid-19 procedures

During the term <u>6th March - 27th March</u> Consip managed **6 procedures** ranging from **medical devices** for intensive and sub intensive therapy, to **swabs and PPEs.**

- Average time per procedure from publication to award: **3 days**
- Stipulated contracts with more than **100 enterprises**
- Managed on behalf of the CAs more than **1.600 orders**
- Delivered, also during the following weeks, almost:
 - 4000 lung ventilators
 - More than <u>360.000 other intensive care equipment (monitors,</u> helmets, infusion pumps, etc
 - More than <u>68 million personal protective equipment</u> (suits, gowns, masks, caps,.)
 - Delivered supplies to over 250 health bodies scattered around the country
